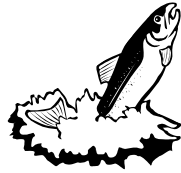


Woodhaven Fishing Ponds



The Fargo Park District, in cooperation with the ND Game and Fish Department, have stocked small water retention ponds in southwest Fargo's --

- **North Woodhaven Pond** (4300 44th Ave. S., Fargo)
- **South Woodhaven Pond** (4802 Woodhaven Drive S., Fargo)

STOCKING REPORTS:

North Woodhaven Pond

Rainbow Trout - adult	400 annually (2006 - present)
Bluegills - adult	231 (2006)
Largemouth Bass - adult	24 (2006, 2012)

South Woodhaven Pond

Perch - fingerlings & adult	900 (2007)
Northern Pike - adult	12 (2012)

ND Game & Fish Department has provided fishing piers for both ponds recently which provides great accessibility!

Rules & regulations - Anglers must possess a resident or nonresident ND fishing license — youth ages 15 and under do not need a ND fishing license. *ND Game & Fish Dept. fishing and boating regulations apply. Each year there are youth fishing derbies held at the north pond for Trout Fest (early June) and a Youth Ice Fishing Derby at the south pond (late February).

We encourage all anglers to practice catch-and-release practices. Other important regulations include:

- No illegal stocking (*state regulation*)
- No swimming (*city regulation*)
- No gas-powered motors are allowed —self propelled boats only (*city regulation*)
- Park is closed from dusk to dawn
